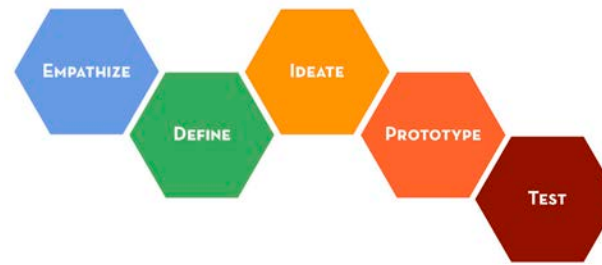


Join a community of young changemakers across the US and Asia

WHAT IS DESIGN-THINKING?



Design-thinking, or human-centered design, is a process for creating innovation that focuses on understanding people's needs. It has been used successfully in a variety of different fields and has great potential for making breakthroughs solutions to problems in our society as well as our own lives.

WORKSHOPS & SPEAKERS

Join experiential workshops on each step of the design-thinking process and hear speakers share their view on design for social innovation.

WHERE WILL I STAY?

During the program, you will stay at a hotel in Palo Alto, close to the Stanford campus. You will be paired with a roommate to enrich your program experience.

The total program fee is \$3,100 USD, and includes: accommodation, welcome lunch and celebration dinner, most scheduled activities, and local transportation. The program fee does not cover: airfare, medical insurance, most meals, or optional activities.
